

4. Where to eat and drink

Keep in mind the dining customs in Korea that restaurants usually serve some side dishes as well as water (nottap water) for free if you order a main menu. Restaurants often open 11:00 am to 9:00 pm, and many of them remain open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. In general, we don't have a set lunch or dinner time in restaurants.



Hanyang Jokbal

(13, Junggu-ro 23 beon-gil, Jung-gu, Busan, TEL: +82-51-246-3039, Business Hours 10:00 ~ 01:00)

One of famous dish in Busan

“Hanyang Jokbal” located in the famous alley for pork hock in Nampodong. Jokbal is similar to Schweinshaxe from Germany but it's different. The most famous dish at this place is “Naengchae Jokbal.” A cold pork hock salad, which is hard to find in other parts of Korea. The combination of steamed pig feet, fresh cucumber, and jellyfish mixed with mustard sauce is must-try food for visitors to Busan.



Jaejuga

Korean Abalone dishes

Located in Busan station, Jaejuga is a Korean cuisine restaurant. Here you can eat lot of types Korea abalone

dishes such as Abalone Rice Porridge, Grilled Abalones with Butter, Raw Abalones, and Abalone bibimbap. This place is newly remodeled interior, so you can have a pleasant and comfortable atmosphere.



Leejaemo Pizza

This place makes really good pizza and they do not use cheap cheese. Leejaemo cheese crust pizza and Bulgogi oven cheese cream sauce spaghetti are best menu in here.

Also you can get self-served refills, get a cup per 2 persons. This place is usually crowded with the queue. This restaurant is closed on Sunday.

Nampo Samgye-tang

(Ginseng Chicken Soup)(16-1, Nampo-gil, Jung-gu, Busan, Tel: +82-51-245-5075, Business Hours: 10:30 ~ 22:00)

Since 1959, Nampo Samgyetang in the heart of Busan has been serving Samgyetang (Chicken ginseng soup) made with fresh, homegrown ingredients. Brewed for as long as 24 hours, the restaurant's chicken stock is rich in flavor and nutrition. Other special dishes include abalone Samgyetang and electric grilled chicken.

Places for HALAL food

There are a few places for Halal food in Busan. **Cappadocia** (123-9, Geumdan-ro, Geumjeong-gu, Busan, Tel: +82-51-515-5981, Business Hours: 11:30-21:00) is a HALAL restaurant located near the Busan Mosque, and serves a traditional Turkish cuisine. There is also another one in Nampodong area called **Bombay brau** (75, Gwangbok-ro, Jung-gu, Busan, Tel: +82-51-256-7828, Business Hours: 00:00-24:00), serving Indian cuisine.



6. WHERE TO STAY

Crown Harbor Hotel Busan

(114, Jungang-daero, Jung-gu, Busan, Tel: +82-51-678-1000)

The **AHLIST** participant price at this hotel is 75,000 KRW for Superior Room, 85,000 KRW for Deluxe Room, 100,000 KRW for Executive Room, and 150,000 KRW for Junior Suite Room. All options include tax and service charge. But 10,000KRW additional

charge applies during weekend. Again, the hotel's normal rate is higher so please benefit from the special discount if you decide to stay in this hotel. Shuttle Bus will be provided by Crown Harbor Hotel for free.

7. HOW TO GET from Airport to Crown Harbor Hotel Busan and ToyokoInnHotelNo2.

The main conference event is at Busan Port Convention Center located at city center, so participants are advised to book an accommodation near the place. **Here is how to get from Gimhae International Airport to Crown Harbor Hotel Busan and Toyoko Inn Hotel**, our two recommended hotels, by Airport Limousine Bus. The Limousines leave airport every 40 minutes and arrives at the hotels 45 minutes later. **Limousine Bus stops at Jungangdong (for Crown Harbor Hotel Busan), and at Toyoko inn Hotel.** The fare is 6,000 KRW (Alternatively, taxi fare between airport and the hotel is approximately 15,000 KRW and it takes 35 minutes).

8-1. Hotel to Busan Port Convention Center

8-1-1. From Crown Harbor hotel to Busan Port Convention Center:

If you stay in Crown Harbor Hotel, the hotel will provide a shuttle bus to Busan Harbor Convention Center for free of charge.

8-1-2. From Toyoko inn Hotel to Busan Port Convention Center:

If you stay in Toyoko Inn Hotel, you need to use Busan Harbor Convention Center's circular bus. The fare is 1,100 KRW. Please see the map [MAP-1] below for details.
